When I eat at New China, the Tropical Mango Shrimp is a must have! The succulent shrimp is cooked in a spicy sauce which is balanced beautifully with a bed of sweet stir fried red and green peppers and fresh mango slices. If you are in the mood for a more traditional Chinese option, the
